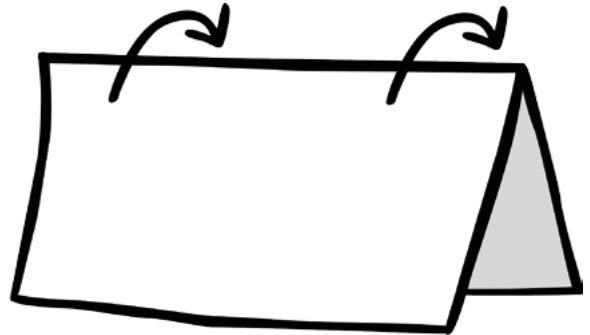


How to make a pirate hat

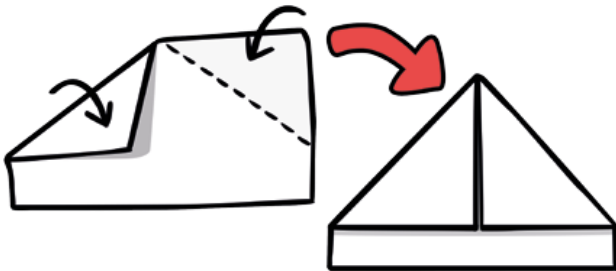
1 Use a large rectangular piece of paper or newspaper.



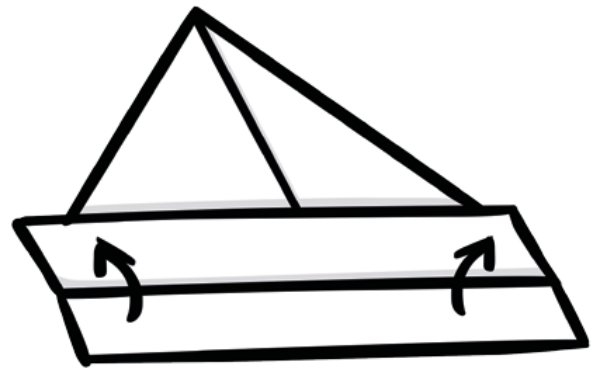
2 Fold the paper in half.



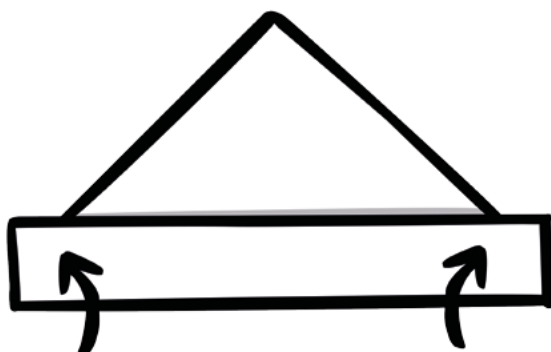
3 Fold over the top corners so they meet in the middle.



4 Lift up the front flap at the bottom and fold.



5 Flip the paper over and repeat.



6 Aarr! Your hat is ready to wear matey!



Pirate Eyepatch

Pirate Costume Craft

You will need:

Pirate eyepatch template

Black colouring pencil or felt-tip pen

Scissors

Elastic or string

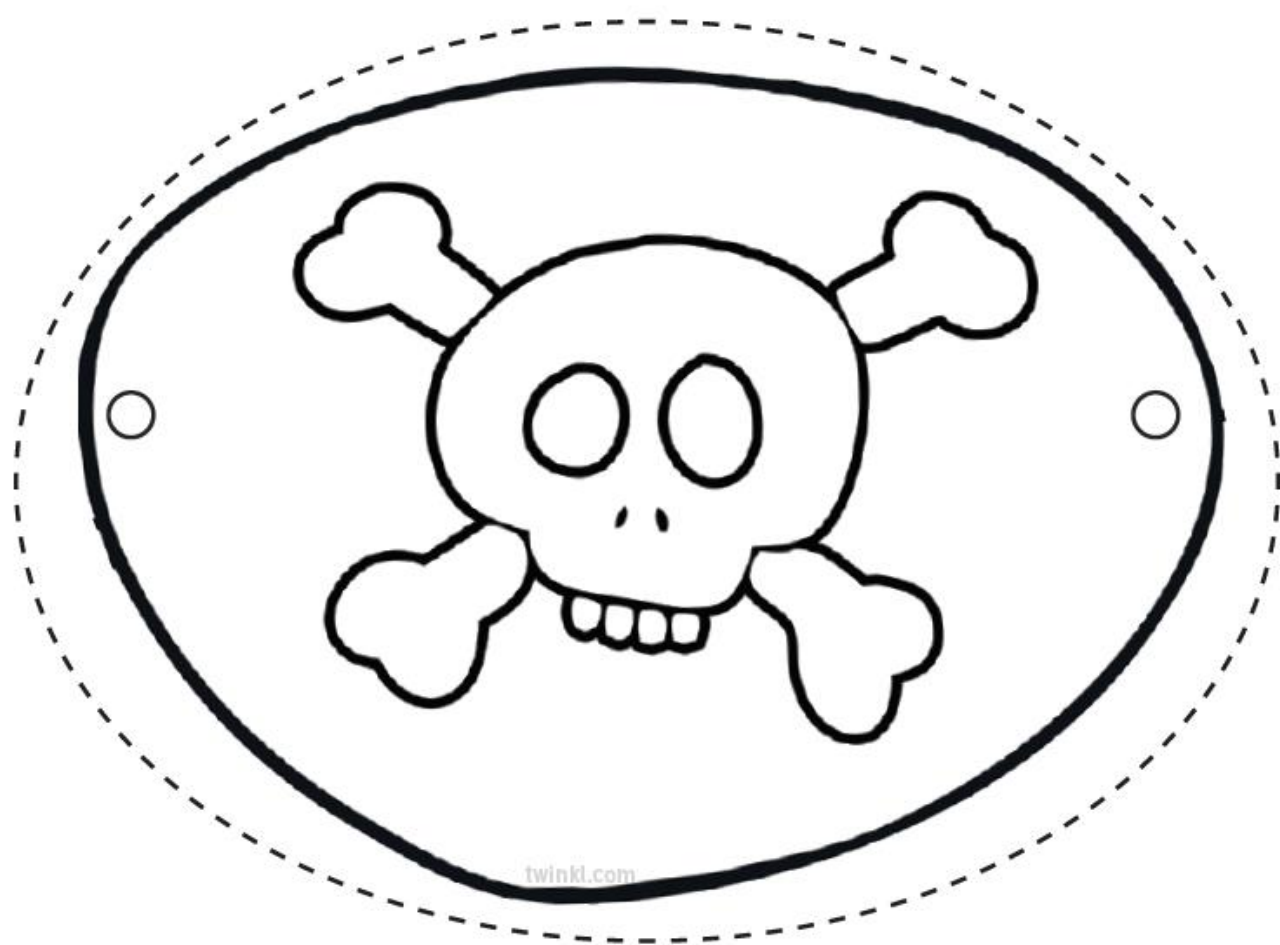
Sticky tape



What to Do:

1. Colour in the pirate eyepatch template (provided). Remember to leave the skull and crossbones white.
2. Carefully, cut out the eyepatch.
3. Ask a grown-up to help you put holes in the eyepatch where the little circles are.
4. Get the elastic or string and put it around your head to work out how much you will need.
5. Then, thread this through the holes. This is a bit tricky, you might need a grown-up to help.
6. Use the sticky tape to keep the elastic or string in place.

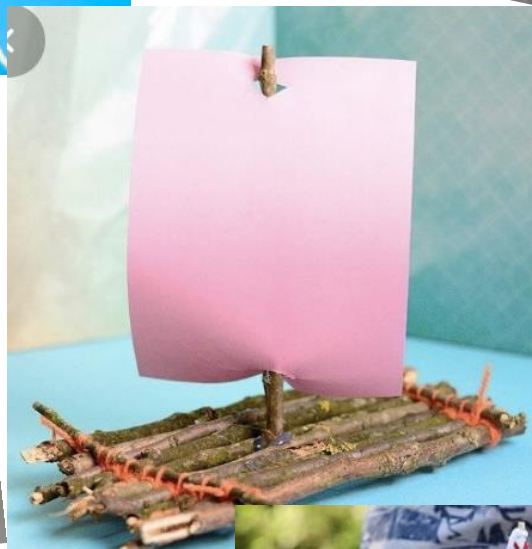
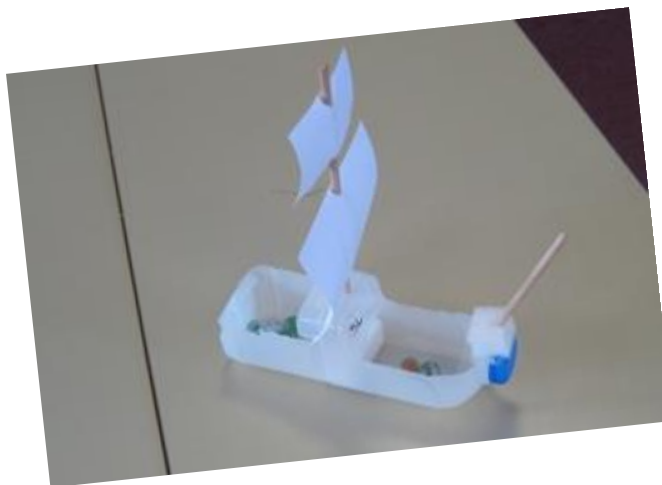
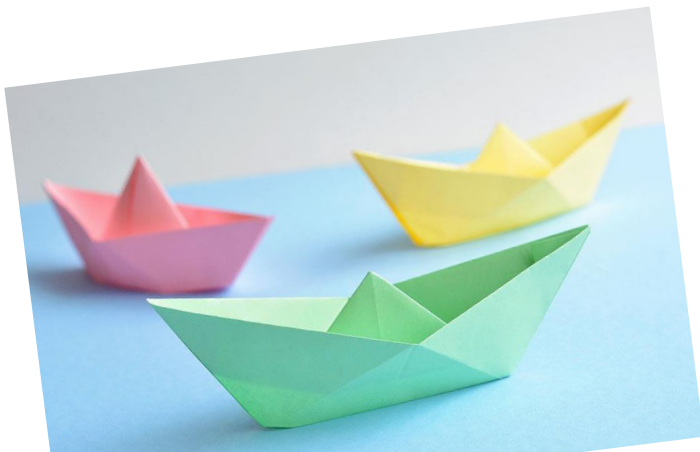

Listen to the instructions being shouted out and do the actions

Man, the lifeboats – Sit on the floor & row

Pieces of Eight- Put arms out & fly around being a parrot & say “Raaaa, pieces of eight”

Crow’s Nest - Stand on one leg, other leg bring up to the side of your knee & hold it there. Put arms up in the air & make a basket shape above your head

Sharks - Make a fin out of your hands, place them on your back & run around the room

Climb the Rigging- Pretend to climb up a ladder

Captains Coming- Stand still, salute & say “aye, aye Captain”

Man Overboard - Jump to the side & swim around

Walk the Plank- Arms out straight & wobble whilst walking in a straight line

Fire the Cannons - In pairs pretend to light the cannon & say “boom” & jump into the air

Hit the Decks - Lay down on your stomach as quickly as possible

Rats on Board- Sit on the floor, lifting your legs up & hugging them with your arms

Port- Run to the left

Starboard - Run to the right

Bow- Run to the front of the room or garden

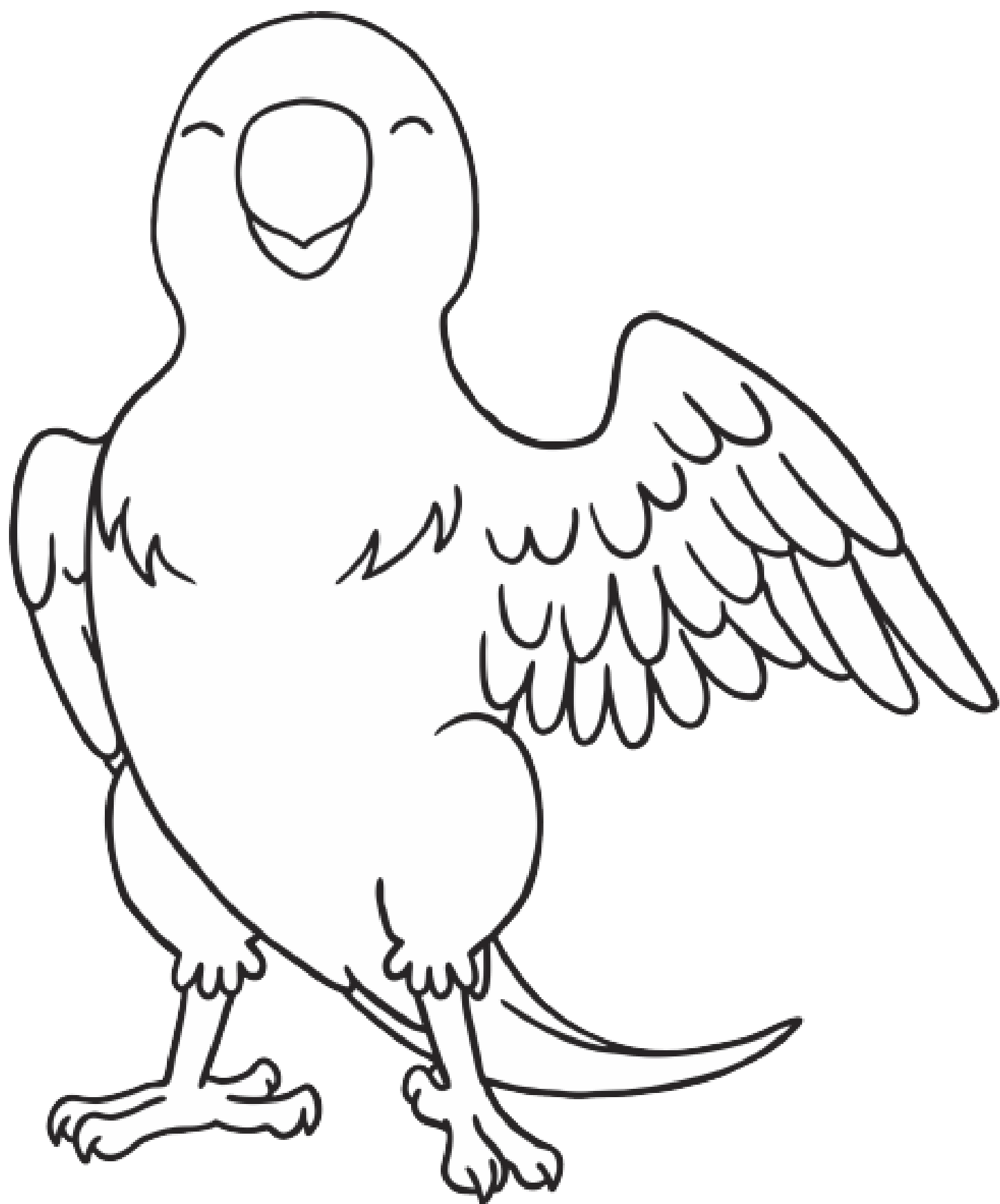

PARROTS





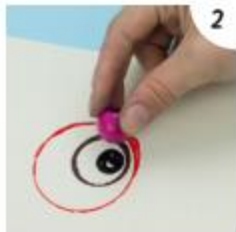
Parrot Printing

Supplies

- Poster paint in red, blue, yellow, green and black
- Cardboard tube or paper cup
- 2 Sponges
- A button, bead or bottle top
- String
- Lolly sticks
- Bubble wrap (or similar)
- Scissors



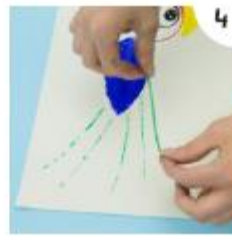
1 Dip the end of a cardboard tube or paper cup into the red paint and press it near the top of your page to create the shape of the parrot's head.



2 Use a button, bead or bottle top dipped in paint to add an eye to the parrot.



3 Safely cut a teardrop shape from the sponge. Dip this into the blue paint and then press it onto your page to create a parrot's body.



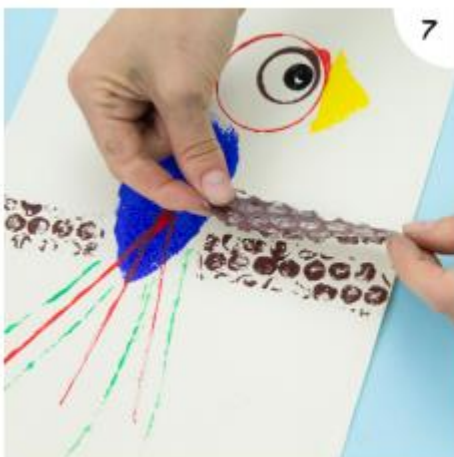
4 Safely cut a piece of string about as long as your finger. Dip it into green paint and use it to add tail feathers.



5 Use the edge of a lolly stick dipped in red paint to create feathers in between.



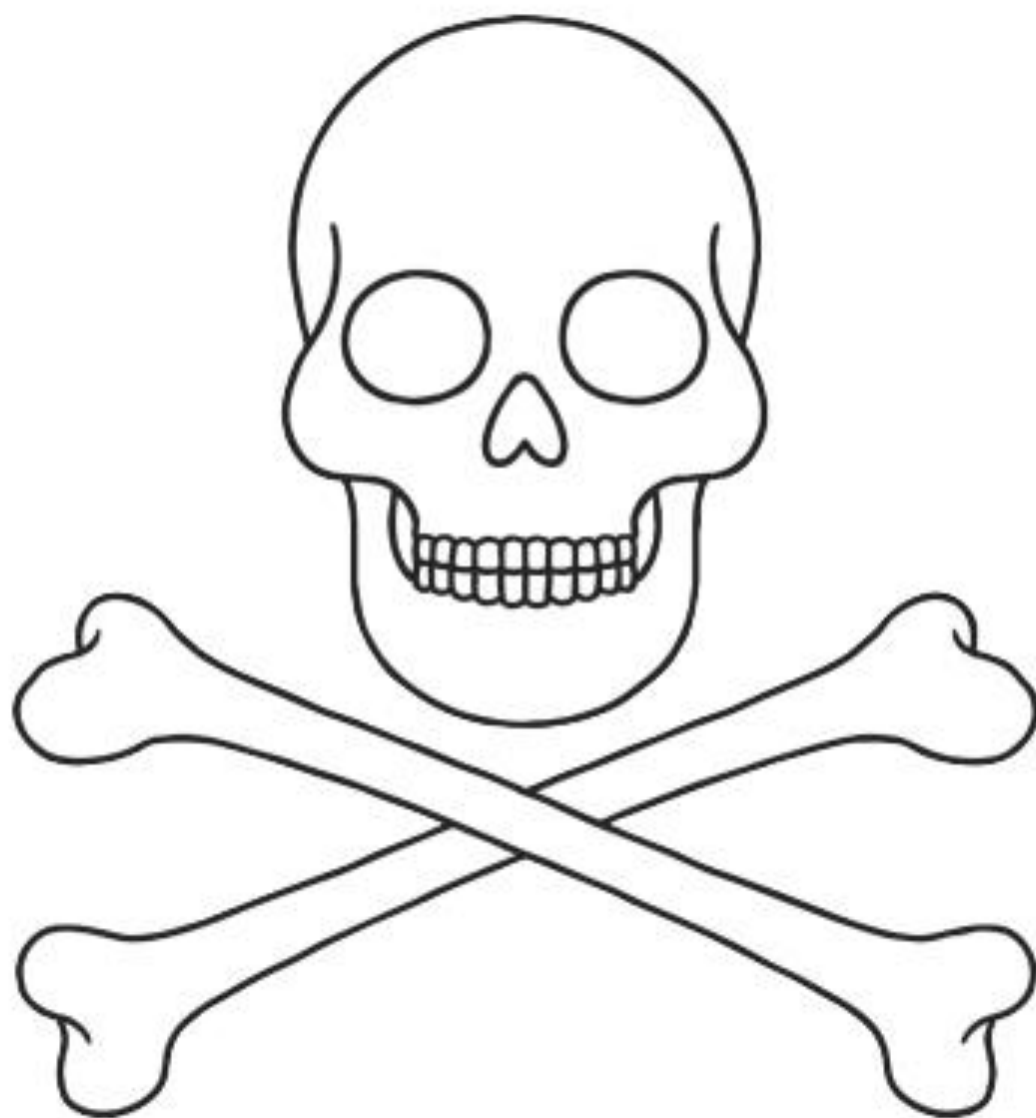
6 Safely cut a triangle shape from the sponge. Dip this into yellow paint and use it to create a beak.



7 Use bubble wrap to add some texture to your background, such as a branch. Your parrot print is now finished.

Cardboard Tube Pirate

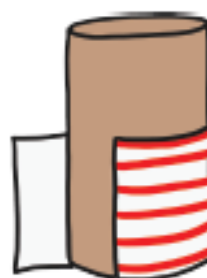
You will need:

- A cardboard tube
- Coloured Paper
- Wool
- Scissors
- Glue
- Coloured pens



Step 1

Stick a strip of coloured paper round the bottom half of the tube.



Step 2

Draw a face on your pirate and stick on a paper beard.



Step 3

Make your pirate a paper hat and hair out of wool.



Step 4

Leave your pirate to dry in a warm place.

Investigating...



Fizzy Pirate Coins



You will need:

baking soda



water



coins



food
colouring



flour
(optional)



vinegar



Method:

1. Clean some pennies to be shiny pirate coins, to do this place them in cola or vinegar.
2. For the rocks, pour your baking soda into a bowl and add water slowly until it makes a paste. (If you want to pad out the baking soda, add some flour when you mix. As long as it's not more than half and half you should still get a good reaction).
3. Add a couple of drops of food colouring and mix well.
4. Either mould with your hands or use cake moulds to create shapes, press a coin into each.
5. Leave in the fridge overnight.
6. Use a dropper to drop vinegar onto your pirate rocks.



The Science Bit



Why does this happen? Vinegar (an acid) and Bicarbonate of soda (an alkali), react together to neutralise each other. This reaction releases carbon dioxide gas, which causes the bubbles you see.

Which worked best at cleaning the coins? The cola or vinegar?
